

Rules to Play Big Grid 400 Squares

Rules to Play Super Squares | Big Grid

1. Prizes are based on a 400-square Big Grid. Each square is an entry into the game. 400 entries.
2. The Big Grid covers all scoring combinations from 0 to 60 (1=4)
 1. Should the score exceed 60, 59 will be subtracted from that score, ie: 64 - 21 is the final score. Subtract 59 from 64 making the Final Score 5 - 21
3. Winners will have exact scores. Each square has 9 scoring combinations.
4. The score after extra point(s) conversion (PAT) is used.
5. A single square may win multiple times due to multiple scoring combinations or quarter-winning scores remaining unchanged due to no scoring in the subsequent quarter.
6. Tied score at the end of the 4th quarter.
 - The Final Score Prize will be split evenly between the tied score and the final score.
7. "Been There" Will be split evenly between all squares that had a score in the game but did not win a Quarter or Final Score.
 - "0-0" is considered the first score and starts the game.
